Home-Port Stables welcomes you to their summer camp program. The purpose of this agreement is to inform participants of the things they need to know in order to have an exciting camp experience. Please review, sign and return on first day of camp. We look forward to seeing you.

Riding Equipment:

If participants have any type of riding equipment please bring it.

Clothing:

Camp participants should bring a change of clothes preferably one pair of jeans or leggings, pair of shorts and change of socks. Ideal shoes for riding and working with horses are boot like with closed toe and heel. Flip flops and sandals are permitted but not when not working with horses. There is a creek on the property and participants are welcome to swim. Please pack towels, and swimming attire.

Food:

Please pack plenty of snacks and a lunch. The Horse-Fort has a refrigerator and microwave that participants may use. We also have a campfire that we will utilize to roast hot dogs and smores. Home-Port Stables can provide lunches at an additional expense of 15.00 per day. If you choose this option please give us a descriptions of any food allergies or items your child cannot have.

Drinks:

The days are long and often very hot. As such, we are constantly on guard about dehydration. Please pack plenty of drinks (preferably water or Gatorade type beverages). If you would prefer Home-Port Stables provide drinks please notify staff of any allergies or preferences.

Bugs & Sun:

We have both. Please pack sun block and bug repellent.

Cell Phones:

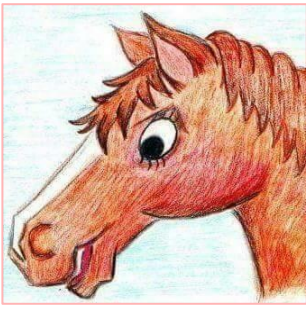

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Liability Release Form & Hold Harmless Agreement

It is understood that horses, no matter how well trained can be unpredictable and are subject to “animal error” as riders and teachers are to human error. Horsemanship and any exposure to horses is considered a hazardous sport and/or pastime. Injuries to participants (riders or horses) can occur at any time. In an effort to minimize injuries, **RIDING BOOTS WITH HEELS, HARD HATS with Harness and SAFETY VEST ARE MANDATORY WHENEVER MOUNTED.** Personal health insurance is strongly advised.

The undersigned agrees to release and hold harmless Home-Port Stables, Nicole Black their employees, assignees or agents, herein referred to as “Home-Port Stables” from any and all claims, suits, damages or costs for any incident arising out of participation in any equine activity including but not limited to: mounting, riding, and or riding instructions, boarding, feeding, traveling within property occupied by livestock of any kind, any injuries sustained to spectators, any and all injuries that may occur when participating in riding lessons, horse shows, events, camps, trail rides, including swimming, insect stings or bites, and snake or dog bites all of which are foreseeably within the “zone of danger” created by equine activities including traveling to and from any equine related activities that results in any bodily, cognitive injury and or death including personal property damage caused to any persons or property regardless of the negligence of Home-Port Stables its owners, employees or agents.

The undersigned further agrees that by participating in any activities (including swimming) at Home-Port Stables they **KNOWINGLY AND WILLINGLY ASSUME THE RISK** of any and all injuries (up to and including death, drowning, loss of limb, permanent loss of cognition, mobility and/or loss of consciousness and any damage to personal property arising from any equine activity, including camps, boarding, riding, spectating, handling horses including being struck by flying debris, trees, bushes, including insect, snake or dog bites or any injury from on going construction, and unanticipated hazards that might arise in the course of riding, training, traveling, hauling, boarding, showing, riding lessons, training or equine camps, of horse, rider and spectator.
